



## **NYEC Meeting Minutes: June 24, 2010**

**Present:** Jean Bibber, Darla Hamlin, Theresa and Tim Porter, Clark Whittier, Jason Raven, Bryce Davis, Katie Murphy, Jen Tyll. Darla welcomed Jean Bibber from the LDS Church.

### **Triathlon:**

- Jim sent info via email. Nelson Smith will see about getting an EMT for the Triathlon. Darla sent an email to Nelson on the subject with a copy to Jim and Linda.

### **Games:**

- The LDS Church will be running two games at Fun Day. Old fashioned games and Velcro balls. The old fashioned games will be done by the LDS youth group.
- A date will be set for a meeting with all games sponsors so that everyone is on the same page for running games.
- Discussion re: how to get prizes for playing games. It was decided to use a 10x10 tent that is staffed with volunteers who will give out prizes to the kids. When kids win at the games, they will get tickets which they will exchange for prizes.
- Tickets this year will be \$1 each, 6 for \$5. Clark commented that a “measure” that is established at the ticket seller’s table really helped with ticket sales!!

### **Fun Day Dollars.**

- Explanation: FDDs are “monopoly dollars” that can be earned by winning games. The dollars can be spent at food booths, higher-level prizes, or area businesses: Toots, Toddy Brook, Stones, Vacationland Video, NY Variety.
- This year the face of the recipient of the Distinguished Citizen award will be on Day Dollars.
- This year’s FDDs will be green!

- T shirt logo:
  - Katie will investigate the idea of digital printing so that the logo submitted can be used in full color. If the cost is still too great, the idea is to go back to the artist (Lena Champlin) to ask if she can give us a new design with specific parameters.
  - Darla will ask Tara Siatris of Winter People for a quote for t shirts with a 5 x 7 logo, 1 color and 2 color. We'll ask Lena to stick to those parameters.

- Jen will order 80 hamburgers, 40 hot dogs. Plus buns. Katie will get mustard, relish, ketchup. And Katie will donate sauerkraut!!

- Avery Kamila from the PPH to be invited.
- Katie to make lemonade, iced tea; maybe Janice Selig could donate bottles of water. Otherwise people bring their own beverages.
